REGISTRATION AND SCHEDULING

NOTE: Registration and scheduling are not available through test centers. Appointments must be scheduled 24 hours in advance either online or via the Pearson VUE call center.

Register and schedule by:

- Visiting the candidate website (<http://www.pearsonvue.com/fdle>)
- Calling the Pearson VUE toll-free call center – 1(877)729-0059 – Hours are in Central Standard Time
 - Weekday Hours: Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.;
 - Weekend Hours: Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Sunday 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- All payments for exam fees are handled directly through Pearson VUE; the test is \$39.

REQUESTING TESTING ACCOMMODATIONS

- Candidates need to request testing accommodations directly through Pearson VUE, as noted in the "[Test Accommodations](#)" section on the website. The Pearson VUE accommodations team will review submitted documentation and send an authorization letter to individuals who have been approved for accommodation. This letter will indicate the time period during which an exam appointment can be scheduled and tells the candidate how to schedule the testing appointment so appropriate accommodations can be made.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS AT THE TIME OF TESTING

Identification Requirements	Two forms of ID required to take the exam (Primary & Secondary): Candidates may not sit for exam without proper identification and will need to reschedule for another time at the cost of the student.
Primary Identification	Must contain a name, photograph, signature, and be non-expired: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Government-issued driver's license/permit• U.S. Department of State driver's license• National/state/country identification card• Passport• Passport cards• Military ID
Secondary Identification Does not need a photograph, but must have a signature.	Must contain a name, signature, and be non-expired: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any primary ID• U.S. Social Security card• Debit/(ATM) card• Credit card

RESCHEDULING AND CANCELING

Candidates must reschedule and cancel exam appointments at least 24 hours before the appointment through the candidate website or the call center. Appointments must be rescheduled within the authorized exam delivery period. All tests with accommodations must be rescheduled or canceled through the call center.

RETAKE AN EXAM

Candidates can retake an exam only three times per year. A passed exam is good for four years.
